


Chalkboard artwork walkthrough

When setting up your CMYK print, please ensure this design is created and positioned on the 'Artwork' layer.




Once you have your CMYK artwork, this must be supported by white ink. To do this, create a spot colour, in 100K only and name it Spot_1. Set this to overprint and paste this artwork, in place, on a layer named Spot_1.


Any other elements which should be printed white only must use the same spot colour as described above.



Once you have you have Spot_1 setup and in the correct position to support any CMYK elements, please duplicate these elements, and paste them on a layer named Spot_2. Once you have done this, create a new swatch, Spot_2, and re-colour the graphics on this layer using the Spot_2



Once you have ensured you have all of your layers turned on, export your artwork as a PDF. This can be using the Illustrator default setting, or PDF/x4a by clicking the 'Standard' drop down and selecting PDF/x4a. Please do not select any other options as this may flatten your layers which are required for production.
